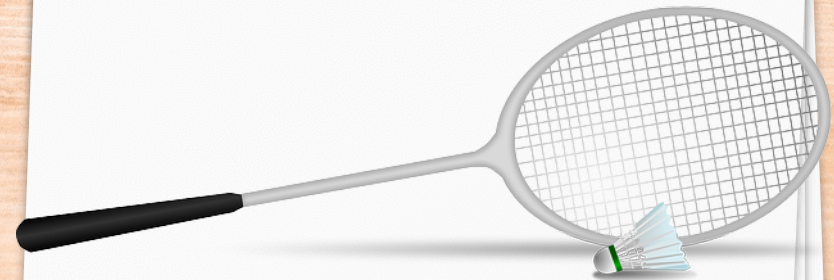


# A Brief History Of Badminton

In 1873, he introduced Poona, an Indian game to his guests.



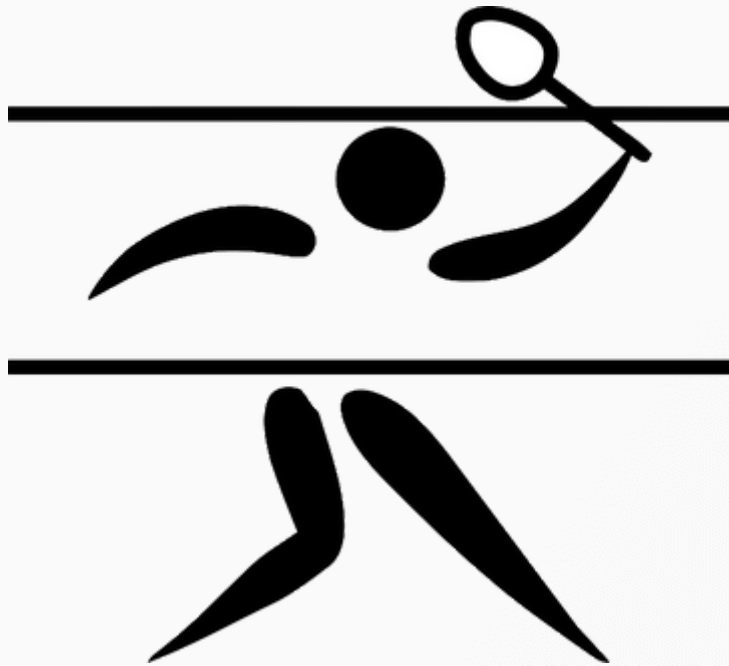
More and more people played badminton.

3 Battledore and Shuttlecock.

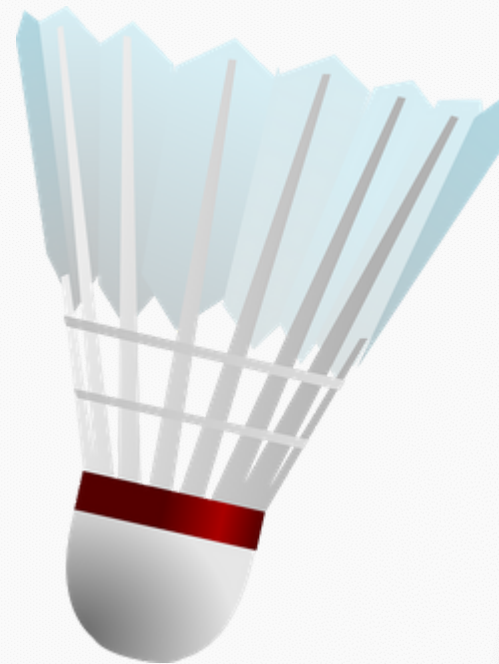




The Bath Badminton Club established the first rules in 1877.
